Mr. FORAKER submitted the following

RESOLUTION:

1 *Resolved*, That the Secretary of War be, and he is
2 hereby, directed to report to the Senate when Herbert J.
3 Browne and W. G. Baldwin, mentioned in the President's
4 message of December fourteenth, nineteen hundred and
5 eight, relating to the Brownsville shooting affray, were em-
6 ployed by the War Department to investigate what hap-
7 pened at Brownsville on the thirteenth and fourteenth of
8 August, nineteen hundred and six, the terms of that employ-
9 ment, and whether any other; and, if so, who were, or at
10 any time have been, employed to assist them or to render a
11 like service, and whether white or colored, with full names
12 and residence of same; and whether the said Herbert J.
13 Browne and W. G. Baldwin and any others who may have
14 been so employed are still in such employment, and under
15 what instructions they have been acting; and if such instruc-
16 tions are in writing, to send to the Senate a copy of the same;

1 and what has been paid said parties, or any of them, on such
2 account either as compensation for services rendered or on
3 account of expenses by them incurred in connection with
4 said employment; and also by what authority such persons
5 were employed and by what authority they, or any ex-
6 penses they may have incurred, were paid, and out of what
7 fund or funds, giving such account item by item.
